ANNUAL REPORT

2017

In 2013, PREA standards, which were assigned into law in 2003, took effect within the Community Confinement Programs. Since the implementation of these standards, CJM has assigned a designated PREA Coordinator, Kim Harris to assure all PREA standards are being complied with at the residential facility.

In an effort to assure all standards are met, PREA posters have been posted throughout the facility, staff trainings have been introduced, technology has been updated and clients have been educated and assessments are conducted at the point of intake.

In 2017 CJM admitted 229 adult males to our program during that time CJM received zero allegations of sexual abuse or sexual harassment.

CJM remains committed to the safety and security of our staff and residents and will continue to promote a safe and secure environment in which staff and resident feel safe.

CJM will continue to strive to provide a safe and secure environment for all residents. CJM will continue to ensure proper training, education; detection and prevention are made available to both our staff and clients.
